

Terms and Conditions of Agistment

Agistment Fees

Your agistment fees are those agreed upon between yourself, the horse owner (agistee) and us, Boneo Park, the landholder (agistor).

There may be a price increase of fees at any time by Boneo Park, but 14 days notice will be given.

Payment in advance is required. On arrival payment will be required until the end of the current month. Agistees will then be billed monthly in advance and are to pay by the 1st of each month. A \$10 per week book keeping fee may be charged on any overdue account.

Boneo Park requires 14 days notification if you wish to move your horse from the property. If this notice is not given, agistment up to the 14 days must still be paid. Horses must not be removed from Boneo Park until all fees owing are paid in full.

Boneo Park has the right to ask any agistee to remove their horse from the property for any reason, giving the agistee 14 days from when notice is given to vacate the property.

Risk of Loss

While your horse is agisted at Boneo Park, Boneo Park shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, injury or death suffered by the horse or any cause of action arising from or connected to the agisting of your horse. All reasonable and proper care of the property is taken by Boneo Park, but all risks are assumed by the owner of the horse. The owner agrees to hold Boneo Park harmless from any loss or injury to the agisted horse. All costs connected with agisting are borne by the horse owner.

It is the horse owner's responsibility to insure their horse and horse gear/ equipment against all risks while they are on the property or being transported.

Ownership / Lease of Horse

If you are not the rightful owner of the horse being agisted at Boneo Park, but have it on lease from another party, you must agree to pay all agistment fees and costs to Boneo Park until such time as the horse leaves Boneo Park. If the lease of the horse is terminated before the horse leaves Boneo Park, you are still liable to pay all costs, and care for the horse, until the rightful owner or new lessee signs an agreement with Boneo Park, or removes the horse from Boneo Park's property.

Vet and Farrier

You are responsible to call and pay for your own vet and farrier as required. Boneo Park will notify the horse owner immediately if they become aware that the horse is suffering from any significant or noticeable sickness, disease or injury. If your horse is badly injured or very ill and we are unable to contact you immediately, we will call your vet on your behalf. All costs must be paid for by you, the agistee. We request a list of your vet and farriers name and phone numbers along with any phone numbers that you can be contacted on in an emergency. If you have not specified a vet on your agistment agreement form, or we cannot get in contact with your specified vet, then we will call the nearest vet in the area in the case of an emergency, and you will be liable for all vet costs. Staff time spent with the horse while it is being attended by the vet or farrier will be charged out as per the current price list.





Worming, Drenching Vaccinating, Teeth etc.

It is a condition of Boneo Park that all agisted horses be wormed on arrival, or you must have a certificate to indicate that they have been wormed within the last two weeks. Horses will be wormed and then kept in a yard / stable for 2 days before going out in a paddock. Worming will be charged to your account. It is your responsibility to maintain the condition of your horses teeth and to drench and vaccinate your horse regularly.

Feed

Boneo Park feeds 2 hard feeds per day and grass hay 3 times per day. Included in the feed will be vitamins and minerals, electrolytes and salt. If you require your horse to be feed more than 2 hard feeds per day or any other variety of hay or supplements these must be provided by the owner or will be charged to the account at cost price.

Horses away at competitions/ vacations – agistment place held

For periods of less than 7 days Boneo Park will provide all feed the horse would normally eat to the owner and full agistment fees are still payable. For periods of 7 days or more Boneo Park will provide the feed the horse would normally eat and a \$10 / day refund on agistment will be given for each day after day 7.

Extra time spent with horse

Any staff time spent with horses that is considered out of the ordinary will be charged to the owners account at the rates specified in the current price list. This includes horses difficult to rug or catch, horses being walked, horses being assessed for sickness.

Helmets and Safety Boots

All persons riding a horse on Boneo Park property must wear an Australian Standards Approved riding helmet. You must also wear protective shoes while on the property. This means all agistees, friends, children, instructors, prospective horse buyers etc.

Control of Horses

All horses must be constrained at all times on the property, except in your paddock. This is for the safety of all horses, people, cars and floats. You are responsible to pay for any damage caused by your horse to any person or their property.

Other Horses

No horses, other than those agisted, are permitted on the property at any time because of insurance issues.

Dogs

Sociable dogs are permitted on the property under supervision. Any dogs being a nuisance will be banned.

Children

Children under 14 years are not permitted unless via arrangement. All children must be under strict supervision at all times.

Speed Limit

Please abide by the speed limit at all times.
